RESOLUTION NO. 77-357  
INTENTION TO FORM COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 115  
ROAD MAINTENANCE IN THE DESERT HOT SPRINGS AREA

WHEREAS, a written request signed by two members of this Board to establish a County Service Area for miscellaneous extended services (road maintenance) in the hereinafter described unincorporated territory has been filed and the Local Agency Formation Commission has approved the proposed formation, which has complied with the provisions of CEQA, and assigned a short form designation L AFC 77-33-4, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on November 22, 1977, as follows:

1. That it is the intention of this Board to establish under the terms of the County Service Area Law a county service area in the unincorporated areas of the County known as Desert Hot Springs, more particularly described by exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. That the proposed name for the area will be Riverside County Service Area No. 115.

3. That the type of miscellaneous extended services to be provided is road maintenance in the territory.

4. That, except where funds are otherwise available from service charges collected pursuant to §25210.77(a), et seq. of the Government Code, a tax sufficient to pay for such miscellaneous extended service will be levied annually upon all taxable property within such area.

5. That a public hearing on the establishment of the area and the provision of such service will be held on Tuesday, December 27, 1977, at 1:30 p.m. in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors, County of Riverside, in the County Administrative Center, Riverside, California. Notices of the hearing shall be published by the Clerk pursuant to §25210.16 of the Government Code. At the hearing the testimony of all interested persons or taxpayers for or against the establishment of the area and the furnishing of said service will be heard.
